The value of the composition development and skillfulness of the performer excellence are credited as they contribute appropriately to a diverse, active, inspiring, thought provoking and unique production that demonstrates **competence in training and expertise.** The judge is to credit the Orchestration and Quality of the Design Development Process with respect to form, body, equipment and the **Achievement of Clarity and Excellence by the ensemble.** Recognize and Reward the successful evolution and staging of musical and visual voicing and ideas through time and space and the active demonstration of skills in all facets of the visual presentation by the Designers and Performers.

Consider: How all ideas and elements are introduced, explored, evolve and resolve within the design through time and space.

TO WHAT DEGREE DID THE DESIGN / COMPOSITION:

CREATE Integrated, Isolated and Unified Ideas and Evolution Through Musical Orchestration and Planning with all Elements of the Ensemble.

DISPLAY Musical Structure and Phrasing.

EXPLORE Creativity, Variety and Contrast.

OFFER Detail and Nuance through Expressive qualities in Form, Body and Equipment.

PRESENT a Range of Responsibilities to the Performer (simultaneous training to support such).

CONTRIBUTE to the **EFFECTIVENESS** of the Overall Program at any given moment and throughout the production.

PRESENT an Achievement of Expressive Opportunities and Training which would capture the words of Control, Technique and Recovery.

DELIVER Precision as a Critical Component of Excellence.

DEMONSTRATE Understanding and Achievement of Effort Changes, Stamina and Concentration are Inherent to Evaluation.
