2019 CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULE

Performance schedules are very tentative until the random draw occurs on Monday evening, November 4th 2019. At the end of each show, awards will be presented and the stadium will be transitioned for the next show. Approximate times for each division are as follows.

Saturday November 9th

- **Patriot A & American A – Hershey – approx. 10:00 am**
- **Patriot Open & American Open – Hershey – approx. 5:00 pm**

- **Yankee A & Independence A – West Chester University – approx. 10:00 am**
- **Yankee Open & Independence Open – West Chester University – approx. 5:00 pm**

Sunday November 10th

- **Liberty A – Hershey – approx. 1:00 pm**
- **Liberty Open – Hershey – approx. 5:00 pm**

Driving Directions

John A Farrell Stadium
851 South New Street
West Chester, PA 19382

From Philadelphia -- Take Schuylkill Expressway (Rt. 76 West) to Exit 26B. Follow Rt. 202 South for approximately 20 minutes. Take High Street exit to Rosedale Avenue and turn left, then proceed to South New Street and turn left. OR, take West Chester Pike (Rt. 3 West) to Rt. 202 South by-pass to High Street exit to Rosedale Avenue and turn left, then proceed to South New Street and turn left.

From Western Pennsylvania (PA turnpike) -- Take Pennsylvania Turnpike to Exit 23 Downingtown/West Chester. Follow signs to for Rt. 100 South. Take Pottstown Pike exit and this will become High St. in the Borough of West Chester. Stay on High St. and turn right onto Rosedale Avenue then proceed to South New Street and turn left.

From New Jersey Turnpike (North or South) -- Take Exit 6 for Pennsylvania Turnpike. Follow Pennsylvania turnpike west for approximately 35 miles and take Exit 24, Valley Forge. Go about mile to second exit, 26 to Rt. 202 South. Merge left twice on Rt. 202 South and continue for approximately 20 minutes and take High Street Exit. Take High Street to Rosedale Avenue and turn left. Then proceed to South New Street and turn left.

From Commodore Barry Bridge (New Jersey) -- Coming from either north or south on Rt. 295, follow signs for 322 West. Cross Commodore Barry Bridge and continue on 322 West to Rt. 1. Turn left on Rt. 1 to Rt. 202 North. Turn right onto Rt. 202 North and go approximately 7 miles. At the Holiday Inn, proceed ahead under the overpass and continue north on High Street to Rosedale Avenue and turn left. Then proceed to South New Street and turn left.

From Delaware, Maryland, Washington, and Delaware Memorial Bridge -- Take Rt. 95 North through Wilmington to the exit for Rt. 202 North (Concord Pike). Continue north on 202. At the Holiday Inn proceed ahead under the overpass and continue north on High Street to Rosedale Avenue and turn left. Then proceed to South New Street and turn left.

Spectator Parking – While there are several parking lots near and around the stadium, the one south of the stadium will be used first. Once full, the upper lot around the Health Science center will then be used. Traffic security and staff will direct you to the proper lot as you arrive. There is no cost for parking!

Handicap Parking – There is plenty of handicap parking in the lot right into front of Farrell Stadium. Traffic security and staff will direct you into this lot when requested.

Spectator Ticket Booth – There is only one ticket booth area and this is right at the front entrance of the stadium.

Stadium Entrance – There is only one entrance, and exit, to the stadium which is right in between the bank of six ticket windows.

Security and Bag Checks – West Chester University does not have any security or bag check requirements.

Vendors/Merchandise – Please allow time, to visit our vendors underneath the stands selling souvenir items and/or recruiting tables for drum and bugle corps. **An official Cavalcade t-shirt will be available for purchase. Championship souvenir program books will again be a free online offering!** Thank you for supporting this important part of Cavalcade championships.

Stadium Food – WCU will have plenty of food vendors and food trucks for your enjoyment. Cavalcade has no control over the food or prices being offered for our event. Please exercise patience and understanding.

Emergency Services – Medical attendants, ambulance and other emergency personal will be on site near the band performing entrance of the stadium.

Handicapped Spectator Seating – Please ask the WCU staff for the appropriate seating area within the stadium.

Videoing / Copyright

Out of respect for the music and visual copyright holders, and to ensure adherence to the law, videoing of any kind by spectators is prohibited. Bands are allowed one (1) staff member to record only their performance for internal use.

Copyright compliance is the responsibility of everyone in the creative process including the marching band director, arrangers, Cavalcade and anyone who records, duplicates or distributes content protected by copyright holders. Cavalcade of Bands is committed to full compliance with the copyright laws of the United States and requires all member bands to comply with all copyright laws which include visual images, audio or spoken text and the display of copyrighted words and images.

Personal videoing (cell phones, video camera, go pros, etc..) is **Not Permitted** at championships. Each band is permitted to have one person record their band only, for educational and historic purposes.

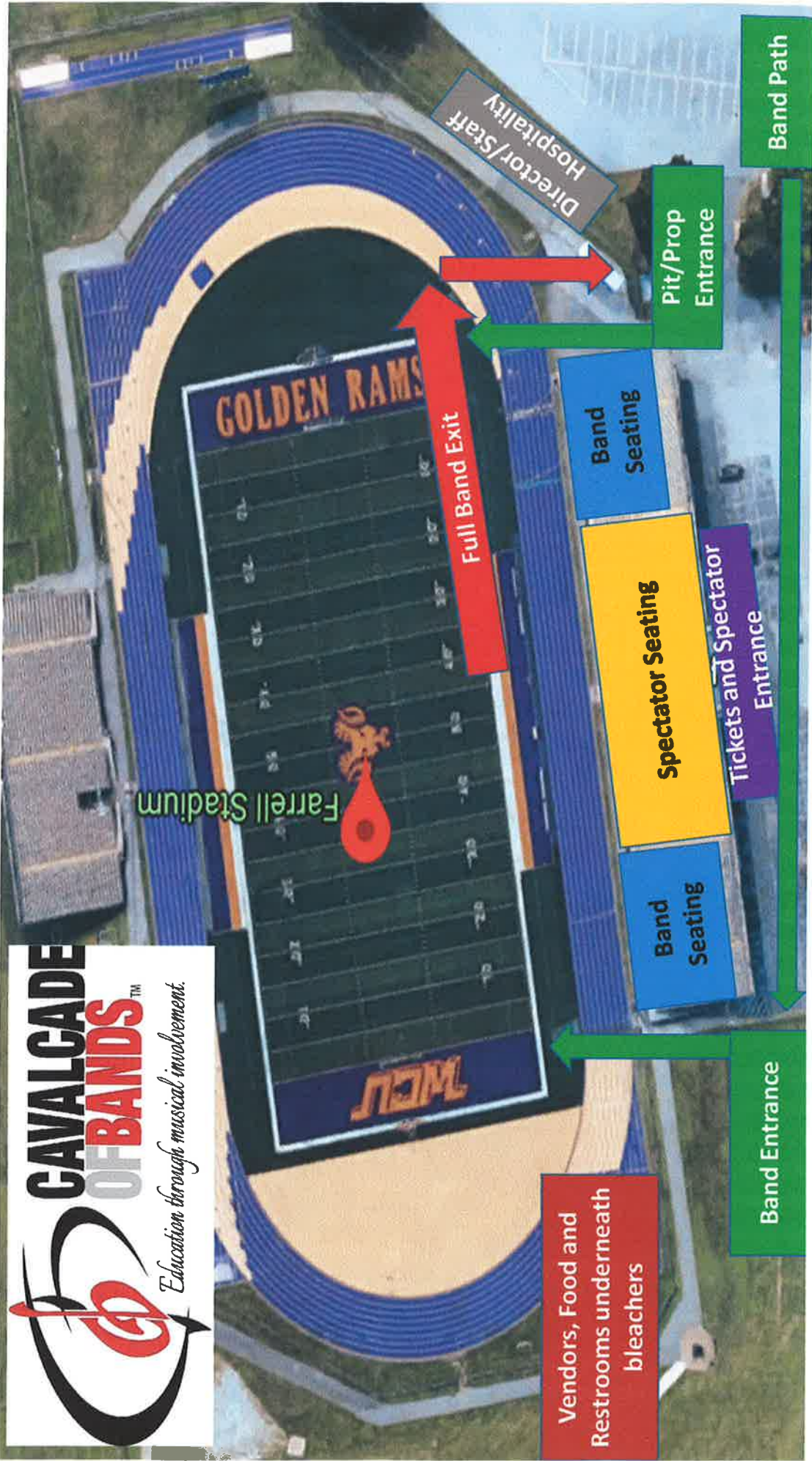
