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Program Content

Orchestration - Arrangements present a positive flow of musical construction and musical choice, **clearly** challenging all performers. (Revised May 2015)

Staging and Variety - Audio visual elements of a continual presentation constantly evolve, develop and enhance the total package.

Musicality - Dynamic phrasing, shaping and unified musical ideas are clearly presented expressing positive moments for the ensemble.

Expressive Opportunities - Through the written score, concepts and directions enhance and elevate the overall musical program.

Creativity - Using all areas of the percussion spectrum, challenges in the writing creates unique and different moments.

Ensemble Support - A true sense of purpose and direction in complimenting the overall brass and woodwind score.

Excellence

Quality of Sound - A proper, representative sound is produced through use of proper, trained techniques. (Revised May 2015)

Clarity of Articulation - Accuracy of the rhythmic portion of the program in all areas of the percussion ensemble. (Revised May 2015)

Ensemble Cohesiveness - Control and understanding with how all parts of the ensemble connect with one another.

Dynamics and Expression - Performing the phrasing, layering and nuances which has been written for each performer.

Implement Control and Uniformity - Proper knowledge and training skills demonstrated through technique, control and overall uniformity.

Blend and Balance - Measuring the performers understanding and commitment to letting each voice be heard within the percussion ensemble and in relations to the whole ensemble. (Revised May 2015)
