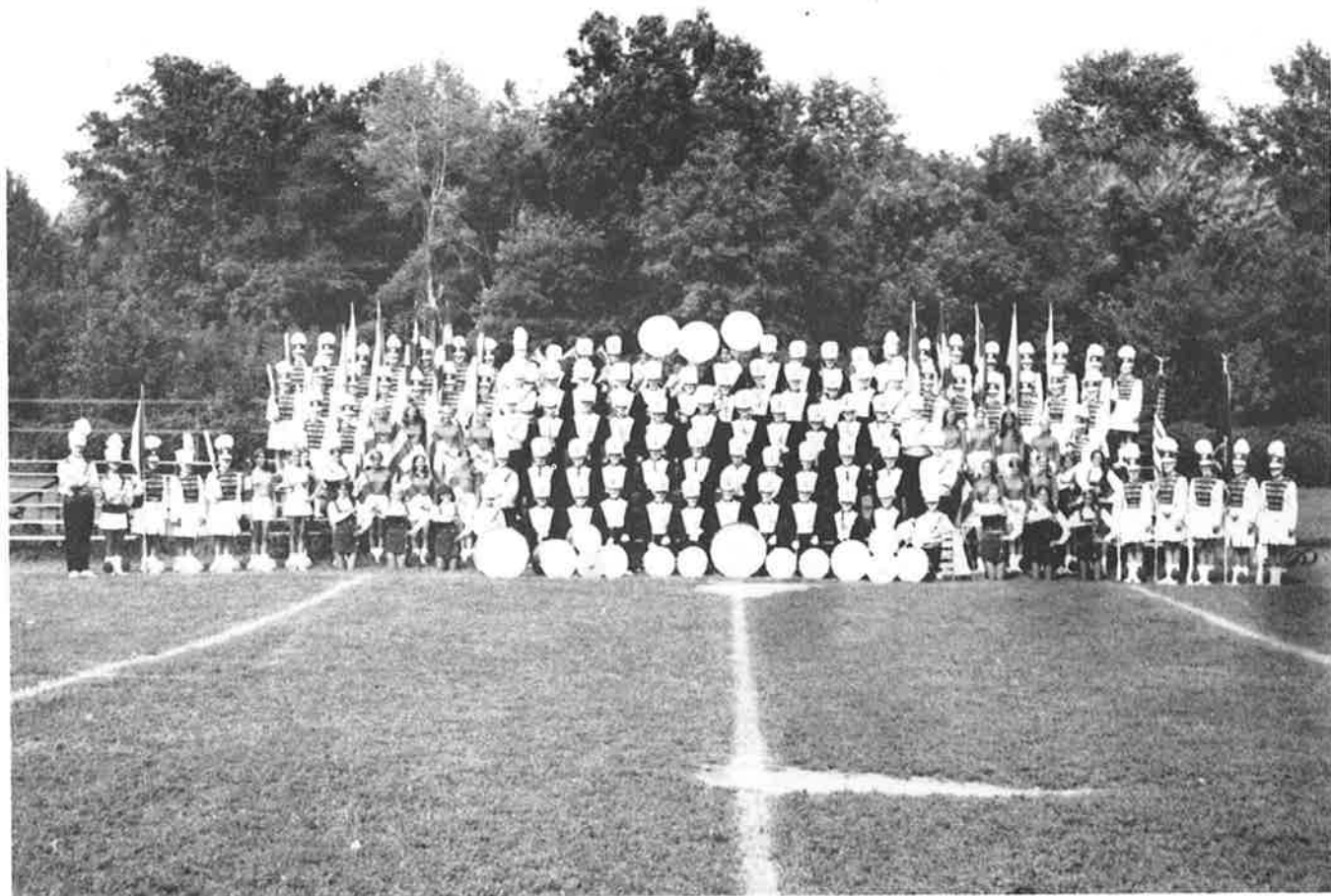


UPPER MORELAND SENIOR SCHOOL MARCHING BAND
