Drum Major for this year's unit is Mark Plotts; Co-captain of the Bravettes are Julie Herman and Joyce Noll; Color Guard Captain, Sue Shaffer and Twirling Captain, Kim Karpinski.

The Marching Braves travel extensively each year. This year they were guest performers at the Little League World Series final game in South Williamsport for over 20,000 people and national TV. At present the unit is planning a 14 day tour of the Mid-West in July, 1976, with the Cheyenne Rodeo Festival as the high point of the trip.
