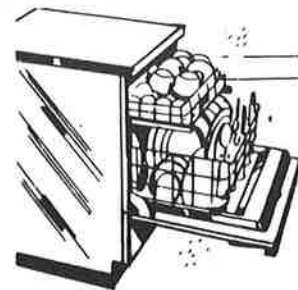

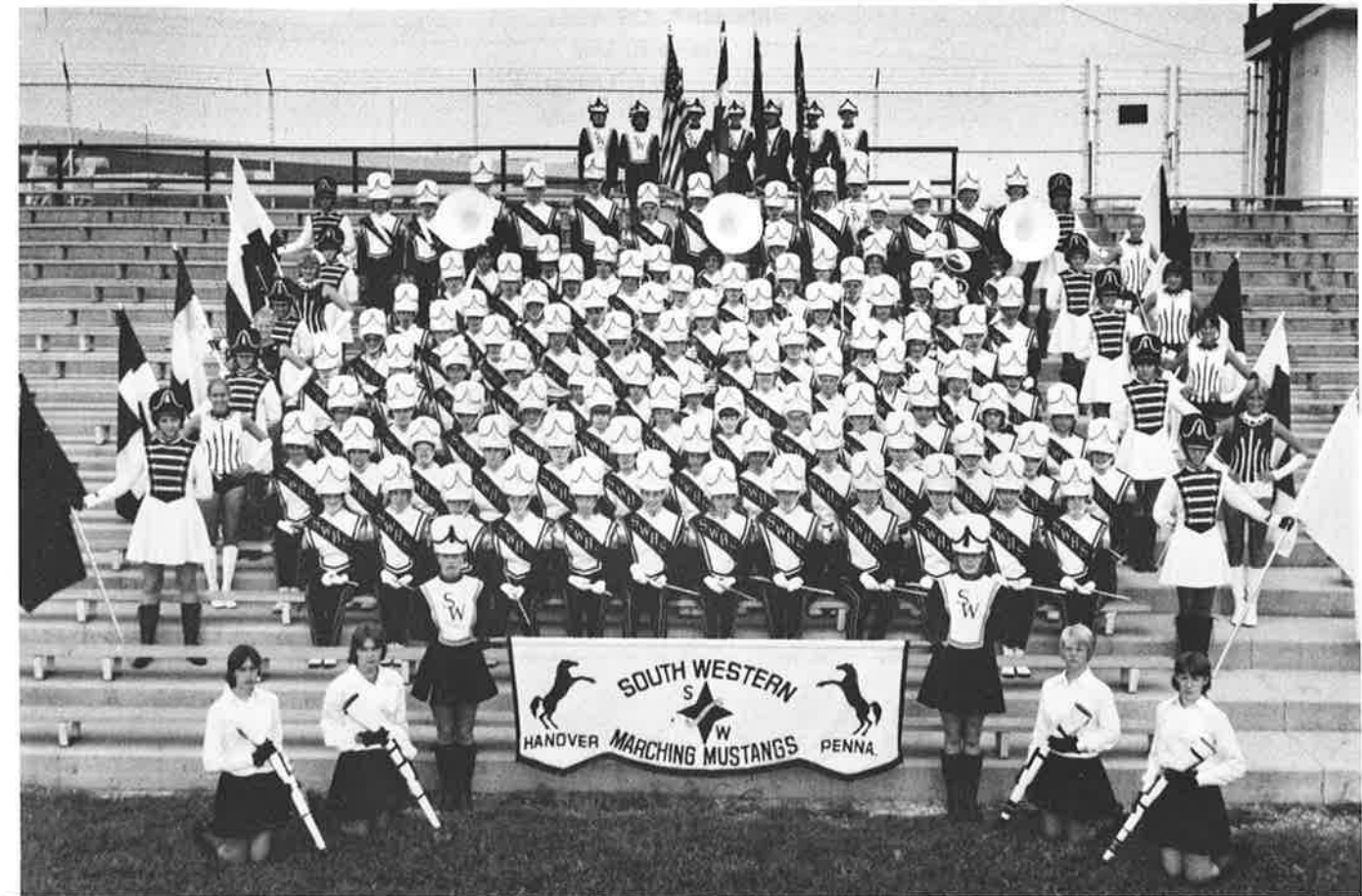

South Western "Marching Mustangs"



The 1975 - 76 'Marching Mustang' Band numbers 120 members from grades 9 - 12, drawing on a total school enrollment of 865 students.

Besides performing for regular school activities, the band has accepted invitations to perform in Pennsylvania, Virginia, New Jersey, New York, and Canada. Since 1971, the band has placed third or better in all parade competitions entered except one, and in the 1974 Blossom Festival held in Niagara Falls, Ontario, placed sixth in their class of 54 bands from across the country. Tonight marks the band's initial appearance in field competition.

Musical director of the Mustang Band is Carey Crumling. While on the field the band is under the direction of Drum Majorette - - Pam Feeser. Feature Twirler is Deb Peck; Co-Head Majorettes are Kathy Merrel and Tammy Harmon; Silk Captain - - Linda Lehr; Rifle Captain - - Julie Rebert; and Honor Guard Captain - - Kathy Nelson.
