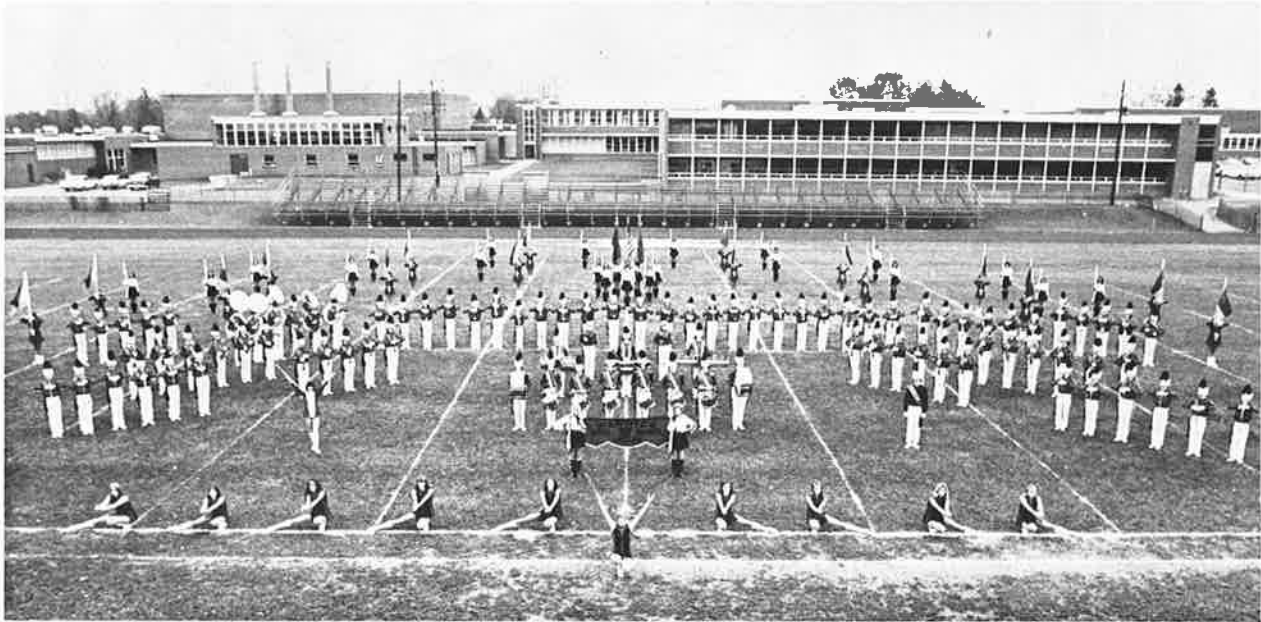


Warwick High School Band *Lititz, Pa.*



The Warwick Senior High School Marching Band and Band Front from Lititz, Pennsylvania, was reorganized by Mr. Dale G. Weller in August of 1969. Since that time the Band has more than doubled in size to its present membership of 157 students and has experienced great success in its musical endeavors. The sincere dedication and hard work of its members, combined with the cooperation of the School Administration, the enthusiastic support of the Lititz area residents, and Warwick Instrumental Music Parents Organization (WIMPO) were all essential in the progress of the unit.

Since 1969, the Band has appeared in numerous parades and field competitions including the Ephrata, New Holland, and Solance Street Fair Parades, Lancaster County Firemen's Parades and Gimbel's Thanksgiving Parade in Philadelphia; and the Ephrata, Lower Dauphin, Shikelamy, Cumberland Valley, Central Bucks West, and West Chester field competitions. Since 1969, the Band has won 30 trophies, including 18 first place, 10 second place, and 2 third place.

Music for tonight's show includes: Entrance—March from "Patton," "Song of the Vagabonds"; Concert—"More and More" (Blood, Sweat and Tears); Colors—"America - Our Heritage"; Exit—"It Was A Very Good Year", "Softly As I Leave You" (Frank Sinatra); Fanfare—"I Gotta Be Me."

The Band Front is directed by Mr. Ralph Lehman. The Twirling Corps routines were created by Mrs. Linda Brown. Special musical arrangements were written by Mr. Ralph Lehman, a member of the Warwick High School Music Faculty. Mr. Jeff Thomas is instructor for the Percussion Section.
