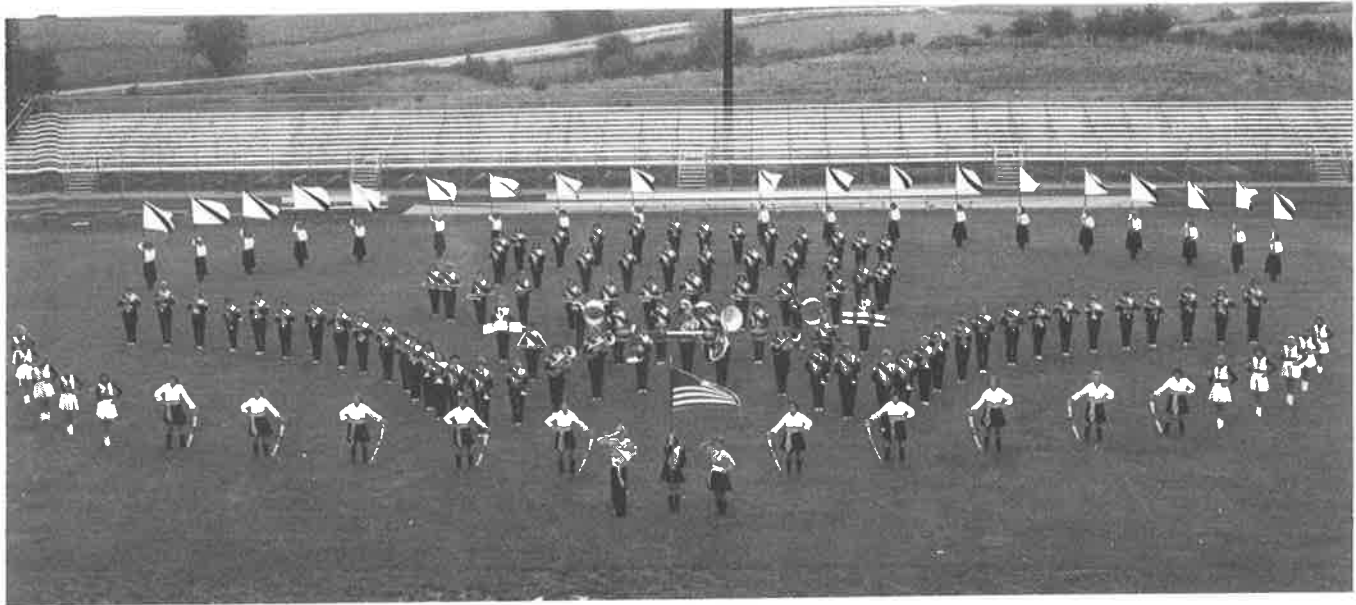


South Western High School Marching Band
