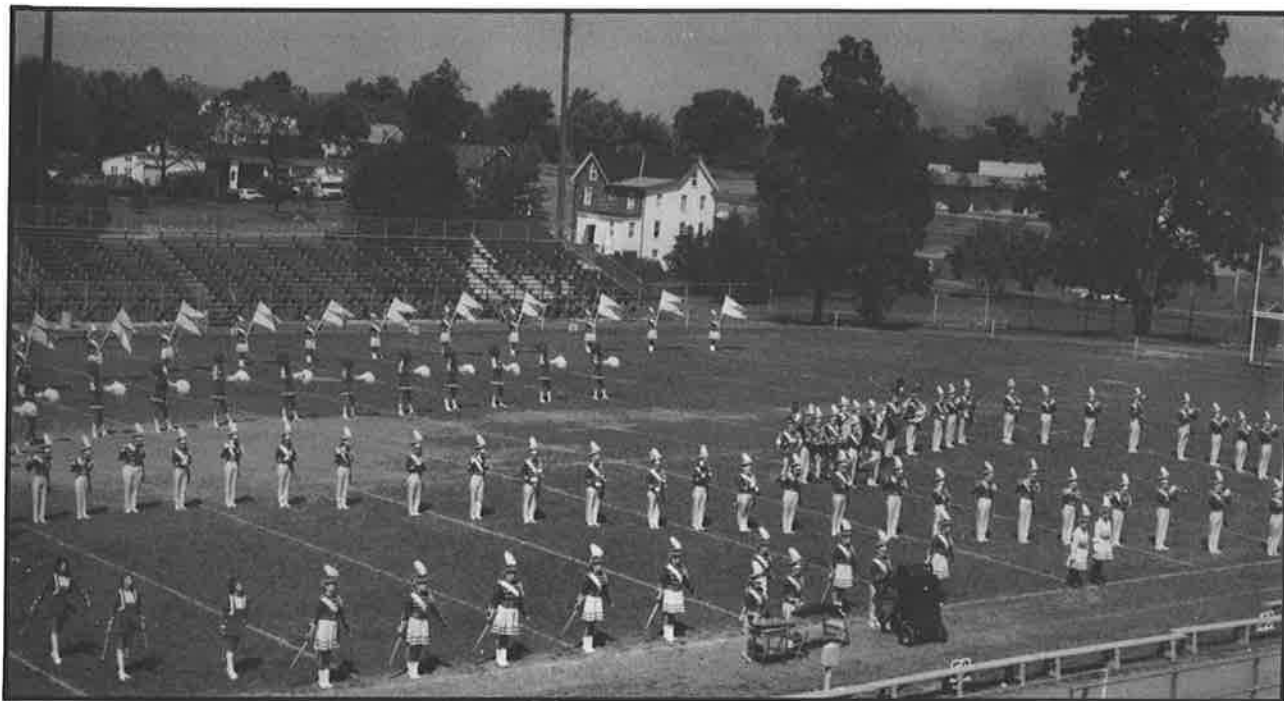


Souderton Area High School
