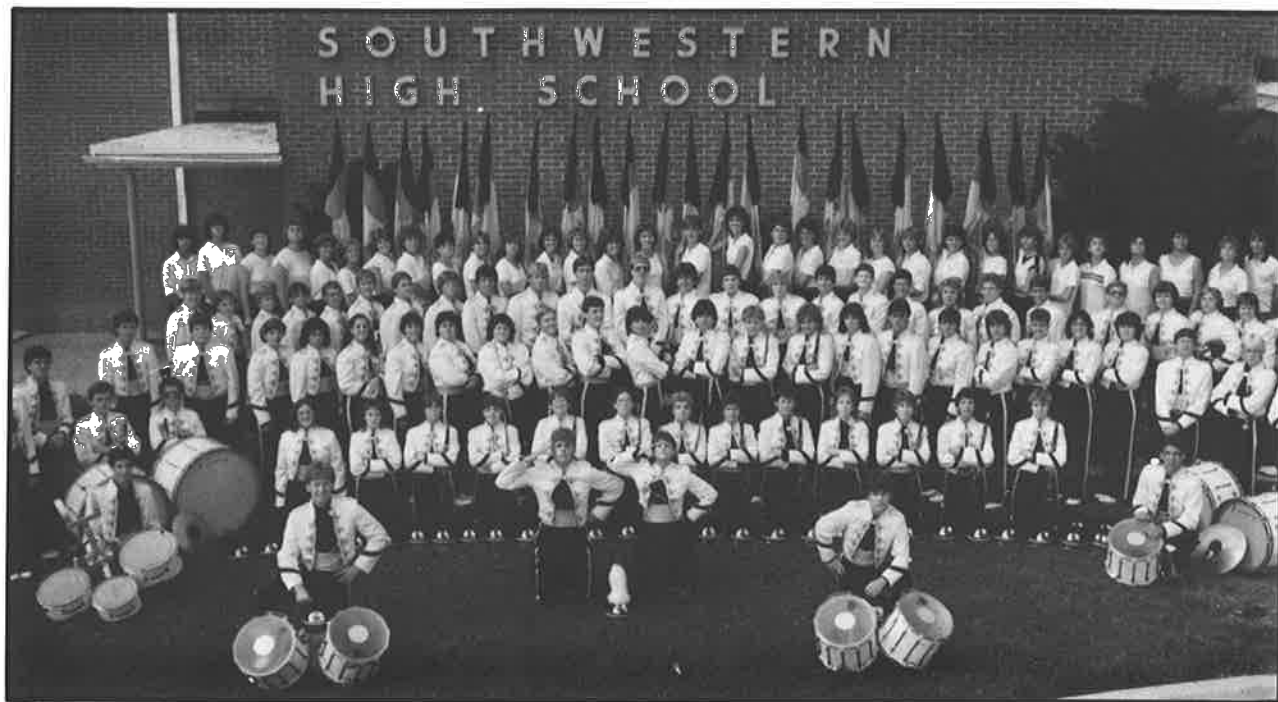


**South Western High School**

It is with great pride that the South Western School District presents its 1984 High School Marching Band. In honor of this, our school district's "Silver Anniversary", the band presents its field production with a commitment to excellence and with the entertainment of you, the audience, as our primary considerations.

This year's show opens with an up-tempo Spanish tune, "Santa Esmeralda", featuring Drum Major, Tim Rohrbaugh. Celebration and party-time is the mood for the band's rendition of Lionel Richie's "All Night Long". We turn back the clock to the days of the big band sound for our concert arrangement of the Gene Krupa hit, "Sing, Sing, Sing", featuring the saxophone section. The finale for this year's production is the beautiful Melissa Manchester ballad, "Don't Cry Out Loud", with an added classical touch of Stravinsky's "Firebird Suite".

The 1984 Marching Band is under the field leadership of Drum Majors, Karen Carr and Tim Rohrbaugh. Silk Captain is Kim Bortner; Assistant is Tammy Clouser. Rifle Captain is Vonnie Krebs; Assistant is Tracey Swartzbaugh.

Beginning his 15th year as director of the Band is Carey Crumling. He is assisted by Skip Rizzuto, Mel Berwanger, Diana Dubs, Russ Berwager, Brian Leppo and Dave Klinedinst. All members of the Band Staff, except one, are alumni of the high school band.

Travelling extensively since 1974, the band has performed in nine states from Rhode Island to Louisiana as well as Toronto, Canada. During that time the band has earned a reputation for excellence while collecting an impressive list of honors including a Cavalcade of Bands Championship, Pennsylvania's Representative to two Mardi Gras Festivals, a performance for the Baltimore Colt football team, and the 1984 Champions of the Battle of the Bands at the Mardi Gras Festival in New Orleans.
