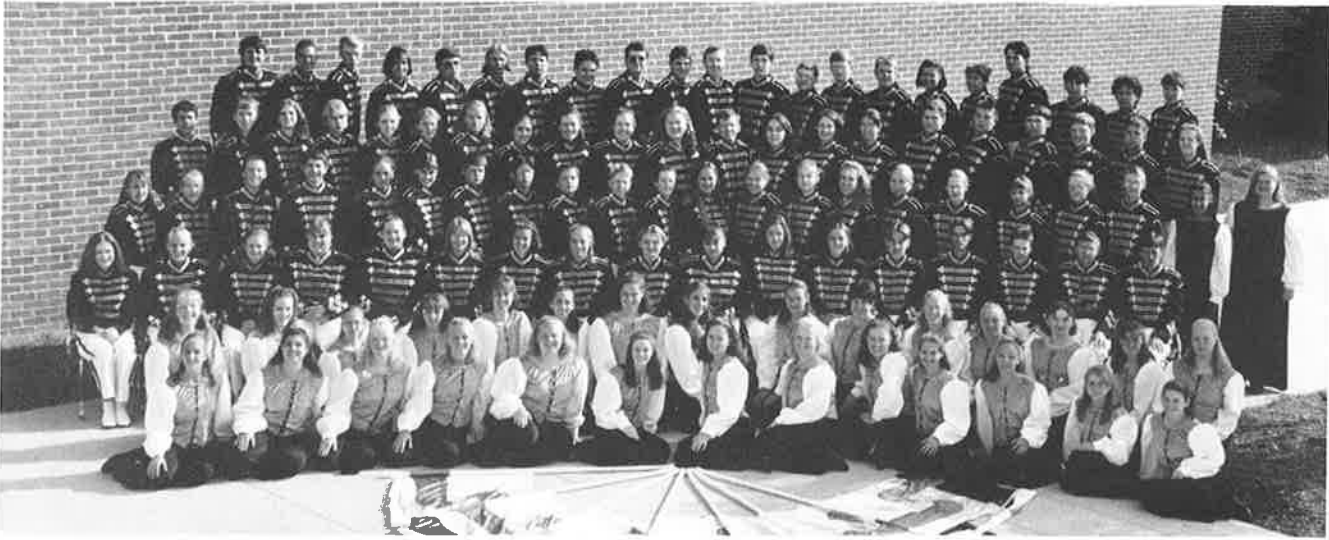


SOUTH WESTERN HIGH SCHOOL MARCHING MUSTANG BAND
