2022 CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULE

Performance schedules are tentative until the random draw occurs on Monday evening, November 7th 2022. At the end of each show, awards will be presented and the next show will begin. Show divisions are as follow.

Saturday November 12th

Afternoon – Independence A
Evening – Independence Open

The official competition schedule will be posted Monday evening, November 7th 2022 on www.cavalcadeofbands.com and Facebook.

Bus/Truck Parking – When entering the high school parking of all buses will be separate from trucks, but within close proximity of each other. Please follow all attendants to the appropriate bus and truck parking locations.

Tailgating – There is no tailgating permitted on the Hatboro Horsham school grounds.

Restrooms – Students – Restrooms for students will be inside the main entrance of the school lobby across from the auditorium.

Spectator Parking – Parking is free and directed by local police and school staff. The parking lot is actually past the school and there will be directional signs and staff to assist with all parking.

Handicap Parking – There is plenty of handicap parking located in the staff, judges and handicap parking area. This is the closest location to the main entrance of the stadium.

Band Check In – There is no need to check in with anyone. **Should you have issues, or an emergency, please text or call Ken Brown at 215-285-1427.**

Spectator Ticket Booth – There is only one ticket booth and entrance to the stadium. This is also the same entrance for all the bands. This is located near the staff, judges and handicap parking lot and will be clearly marked.

- Tickets purchased via website or mobile are subject to \$2.10 convenience fee
- Credit Card purchases are subject to 3.0% Visa/Mastercard/Discover card fee
- Tickets may be purchased at the gate on the day of the event using cash or credit card
- Spectators purchasing tickets at the gate may experience delays when entering the stadium until ticket details are uploaded to scanners
- **We encourage EVERYONE to purchase tickets online prior to the show**

**** Make sure to have your ticket before you go through the entrance gate. The ticket booth is outside of the entrance gate. ****

Security and Bag Checks – There are no security or bag checks at this venue.

Stadium Entrance – All pit, props and motorized vehicles will enter through the left side of the main entrance gate. Spectators will be entering through the right side of the gate.

Restrooms Spectators – These are located inside the stadium in the main concourse area before entering the bleachers.

Handicapped Spectator Seating – The handicapped viewing area is at the end of the stadium, closest to the scoreboard. There is a wheelchair ramp in this location.

Stadium Food – There will be food vendors inside the stadium for your enjoyment. Cavalcade has no control of the food or prices being offered at this event.

Emergency Services – This will be provided by Horsham Township Fire Company and Horsham Township Police Department.

Band Warm Up Location – There are three warmup locations in the back of the school. These will be clearly marked and are on their way to the stadium. **Dr. Beat or Glock Blocks are NOT allowed in the warmup area. If these are used, a Cavalcade of Bands representative will address the staff member or Band Director to stop immediately. If this continues, the Executive Director, or assigned Cavalcade of Bands Administrator, will assess a penalty to the offending band's performance.**

Travel Time to Gate – Please allow at least 15 minutes, to travel to the stadium from the warmup areas. This includes all pit equipment and props. There will not be a monitor of the warmup area but there should be parking attendants in this region to help with questions.

Band Performance Time – Please report to the entrance gate 15 minutes prior to your scheduled performance time. A Cavalcade of Bands Chief Judge will be there to guide you through this area, into the end zone staging area and proper entrance onto the field.

Pit Equipment, Props and Motorized Vehicles

- **All pit, props and motorized vehicles will enter through the left side of the main entrance gate**
- Spectators will be entering through the right side of the gate
- **All equipment and props must have air pressure wheels**
- *Please be flexible with any last-minute requirements from Hatboro Horsham ground staff*
- Please exercise extreme caution when entering and exiting the field

Announcer – Your announcer will be provided by Cavalcade, and they will be located on the track. Every band must use this announcer, along with the Cavalcade standard announcement procedures outlined in our marching band rules.

Judging Area – Will be inside the press box and on the outer wings of the press box.

Field Exit – Bands will exit the field and stadium through the side 2 gate exit.

Band Re-entry – For bands and staff, who have performed and are reentering the stadium, please use the band exit gate on side 2 of the stadium.

Band Seating – All bands must sit in the very outer edges of the spectator stands, and must have adult supervision. Noise in this area should be constantly monitored throughout the show, and kept to a minimum, especially when other bands are performing. Overflow seating, after the front stands are fully occupied, will be on the visitor side of the stadium.

Director and Staff Hospitality – There will be a hospitality room in the building behind the stadium for directors, band staff, judges and administration ONLY.

Vendors/Merchandise – Please allow time, no matter when you perform, for students to visit our vendors. This is especially important at the very end of the show. There will be plenty of time after the last performance, and before scores are announced to visit our vendors.

Official T-Shirt Vendor – Main Event Sports Wear will have t-shirts, sweatshirts and other items for sale at the event. This will be the only available time to purchase a championship item, so please visit their table throughout the day.

Awards Ceremony – *Information and details on this awards ceremony will be communicated to directors separately, well in advance of championships, via email. **Band Directors are encouraged to present their school awards with the Cavalcade representative.***

Inclement Weather – In the event of inclement weather, Cavalcade administration, board members and Hatboro Horsham school staff will meet to address the situation and determine an action plan. This could be a delay, postponement or cancellation of the event. Information will be communicated to directors through Competition Suite text messaging and the stadium announcer.

Videoing / Copyright

- Out of respect for the music and visual copyright holders, and to ensure adherence to the law, videoing of any kind by spectators is prohibited.
- **Bands are allowed one (1) staff member, with proper Cavalcade credentials, to record only their performance for internal use.**
- *Copyright compliance is the responsibility of everyone in the creative process including the marching band director, arrangers, Cavalcade and anyone who records, duplicates or distributes content protected by copyright holders. Cavalcade of Bands is committed to full compliance with the copyright laws of the United States and requires all member bands to comply with all copyright laws which include visual images, audio or spoken text and the display of copyrighted words and images.*
- Personal videoing (cell phones, video camera, go pros, etc..) is **Not Permitted** at championships. Each band will be permitted to have one person to record their band's only, for educational and historic purposes.
- Cavalcade of Bands is fully committed to ensuring that our events are compliant with all music, video and performance rights copyright laws. This is at the request of our band directors, staff and Board of Directors. There are serious financial consequences for anyone breaking these laws.

Official Pictures – Jolesch Enterprises will take group and section photos of every band after their performance. The location off this will be in the parking lot across from bus parking and next to truck parking. **Please go directly there before loading trucks.** Band members will have the opportunity to order pictures, after their photo is taken or order online at: www.bandgroupphotography.com.
