BAND INFORMATION

Bus/Truck Parking – All buses and trucks should enter campus at **175 700 Road, New Oxford, PA 17350** (Conewago Valley Intermediate School). Please DO NOT put New Oxford High School into your GPS.

Restrooms – Students – Restrooms for students will be inside the Intermediate school and will be the first stop before parking buses.

Band Check In/Wristbands – There is no need to check in with anyone with Cavalcade of Bands. New Oxford volunteers will still greet bands as they enter and distribute show

packets/wristbands. *Should you have issues, or an emergency, please text or call Jim Fulkroad at 717-525-0115.*

Stadium Entrance – All pit, props, motorized vehicles, and band members will enter through a separate gate on side 1 away from spectators.

Band Warm Up Location – There are multiple warmup locations behind the school. These will be clearly marked and are on their way to the stadium. **Dr. Beat or Glock Blocks are NOT allowed in the warmup area. If these are used, a Cavalcade of Bands representative will address the staff member or Band Director to stop immediately. If this continues, the Executive Director, or assigned Cavalcade of Bands Administrator, will assess a penalty to the offending band's performance.**

Travel Time to Gate – Please allow at least 15 minutes to travel to the stadium from the warmup areas. This includes all pit equipment and props. There will not be a monitor of the warmup area but there will be parking attendants in this region to help with questions.

Band Performance Time – Please report to the entrance gate 15 minutes prior to your scheduled performance time. A Cavalcade of Bands Chief Judge will be there to guide you through this area, into the end zone staging area and proper entrance onto the field.

Pit Equipment, Props and Motorized Vehicles

- All pit, props and motorized vehicles will enter through the band entrance gate
- All equipment and props must have air pressure wheels
- **Tractors CAN NOT drive on the turf field**
- *Please be flexible with any last-minute requirements from New Oxford ground staff*
- Please exercise extreme caution when entering and exiting the field

Announcer – Your announcer will be provided by Cavalcade, and they will be located on the track (weather permitting). Every band must use this announcer, who will use the Cavalcade standard announcement procedures outlined in our marching band rules.

Stadium Judging Area – All judges will be in the press box, as there is plenty of room. There are outer wings of the press box should anyone need to use this location.

Video Recording Area – There will be a dedicated band staff recording area underneath the press box by the side 1 45-yard line.

Field Exit – Bands will exit the field and stadium through the side 2 exit gate.

Band Re-entry – For bands and staff, who have performed and are reentering the stadium, **please use the band exit gate on side 2 of the stadium.** Will be provided to all students upon arrival or at the band entrance gate. Staff passes or wristbands will be needed to reenter.

Band Seating – All bands must sit in the very outer edges of the spectator stands, and must have adult supervision. Noise in this area should be constantly monitored throughout the show, and kept to a minimum, especially when other bands are performing. Overflow seating, after the front stands are fully occupied, will be on the visitor side of the stadium.

Director and Staff Hospitality – There will be a hospitality room in the Auxiliary Gym for directors, band staff, judges, and administration ONLY.

Student and Parents Stadium Food – There will be concessions, candy grams, and baked goods available on the home side of the stadium. Cavalcade has no control of the food or prices being offered at this event.

Awards Ceremony – *Band Directors are encouraged to present their school awards with the Cavalcade representative.*

BAND and SPECTATOR INFORMATION

Emergency Services – This will be provided by Adams Regional EMS

Inclement Weather – In the event of inclement weather, Cavalcade administration, board members and New Oxford school staff will meet to address the situation and determine an action plan. This could be a delay, postponement, or cancellation of the event. Information will be communicated to directors through Competition Suite text messaging and the stadium announcer.

Official Merchandise Vendor – NorthWest Designs Inc will have t-shirts, sweatshirts, and other items for sale at the event. While they do have a web site, we encourage everyone to purchase a championship item at the event throughout the day. Their website is: <https://nwd.ink/>

Official Pictures – Lifetouch Photography will take photos of every band after their performance. These will be taking inside the Main Gym, which is on route back to the truck/bus parking area. SPECTATOR INFORMATION

Spectator Parking – Parking is free and directed by school staff. There will be directional signs and staff to assist with all parking.

Handicap Parking – Is located behind the bleachers and off Oxford Rd. This is the closest location to the main entrance of the stadium.

Tailgating – There is no tailgating permitted on the New Oxford school grounds. The use of grills is prohibited due to the potential fire hazard.

Spectator Ticket Booth – There is only one ticket booth and entrance to the stadium. This is located on side one, nearest the spectator parking lot. There will be directional signs located to direct you to this area.

- All seating is general admission
- Please order your tickets on line to avoid a line entering the stadium
- Tickets are good for the entire day/evening

Wristbands – Wristbands will be provided to everyone as you enter the stadium with a ticket. You will need this to get back into the stadium.

Security and Bag Checks – There are no security or bag checks at this venue.

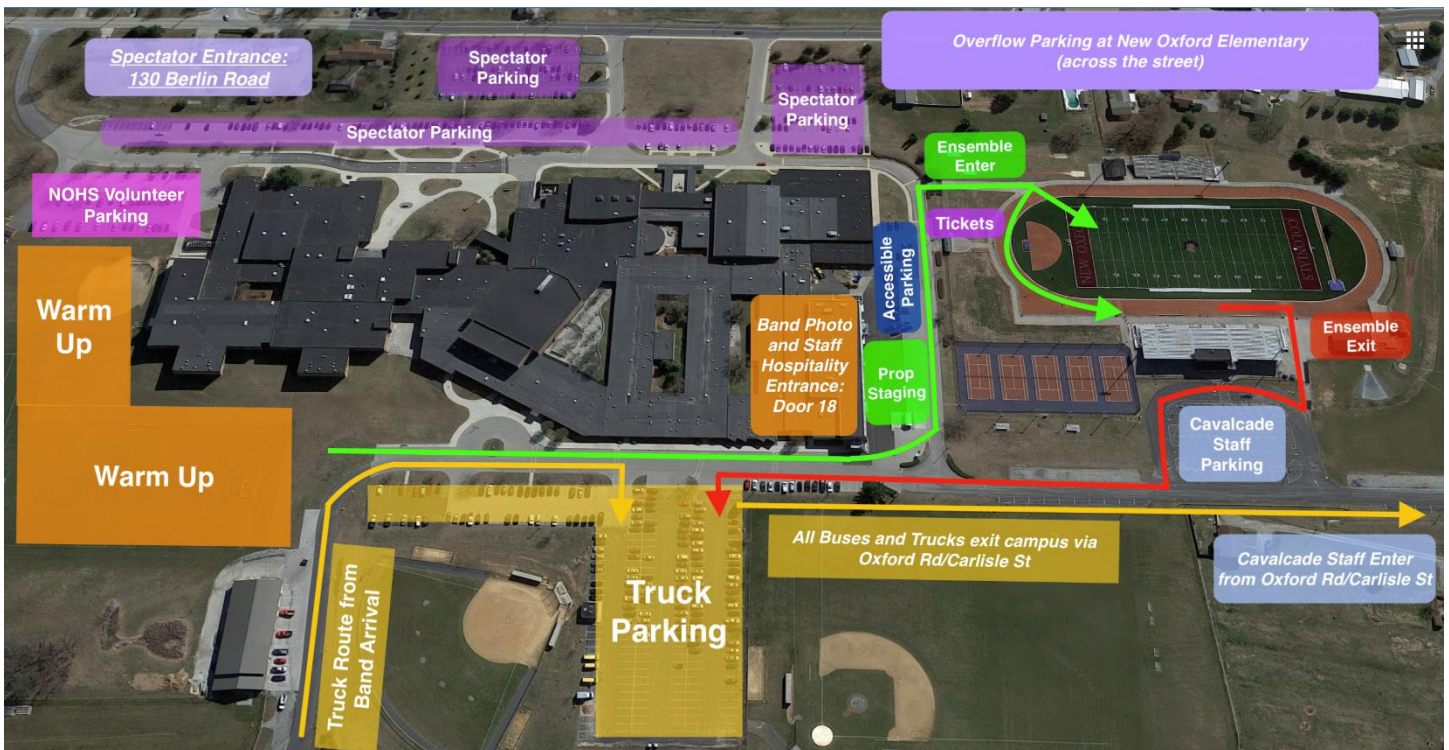
Restrooms - Spectators – These are located on both sides of the main stands. Mens restrooms are on the side closest to the ticket gate, and womens restrooms are on the side closest to concessions.

Handicapped Spectator Seating – There are ramps on each side of the bleachers, and there are wheelchair-accessible seating areas along the front row of the stands.

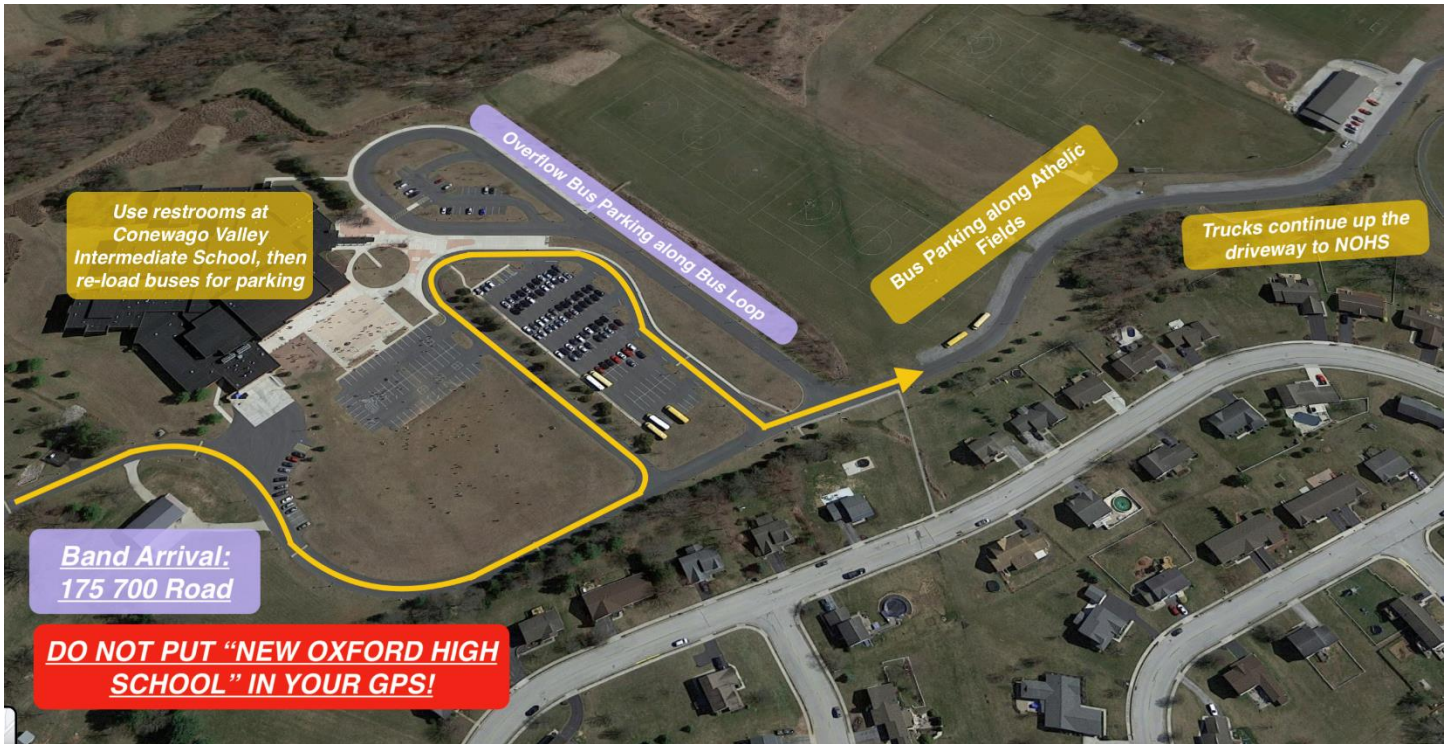
Videoing / Copyright

- Out of respect for the music and visual copyright holders, and to ensure adherence to the law, videoing of any kind by spectators is prohibited.
- Bands are allowed one (1) staff member, with proper Cavalcade credentials, to record only their performance for internal use.
- *Copyright compliance is the responsibility of everyone in the creative process including the marching band director, arrangers, Cavalcade, and anyone who records, duplicates, or distributes content protected by copyright holders. Cavalcade of Bands is committed to full compliance with the copyright laws of the United States and requires all member bands to comply with all copyright laws which include visual images, audio or spoken text and the display of copyrighted words and images.*
- Personal videoing (cell phones, video camera, go pros, etc..) is Not Permitted at championships. Each band will be permitted to have one person to record their band's only, for educational and historic purposes.
- Cavalcade of Bands is fully committed to ensuring that our events are compliant with all music, video, and performance rights copyright laws. This is at the request of our band directors, staff, and Board of Directors. There are serious financial consequences for anyone breaking these laws.
